

CHECKLIST FOR YOU GROUP'S ISSUE OF *euRRRRope!*

- Our issue has a cover – one that looks like a magazine cover.
 - The cover includes the masthead (= the name of the magazine), the issue number (= our group number) with the year of publication etc. (see the PDF “Magazine template” on <https://face-the-challenge.eu/finnish-meeting.html>).
- In our issue, we present at least five companies, organizations, public sector entities, individual people etc. that have done something concrete to diminish the problem related to plastics.
 - We have at least one case from each partner country.
 - The Finns have prepared one more case from any country in the world.
 - We have made sure that other groups have not covered any of “our” cases.
 - In terms of format, we have taken into account the “Magazine template” mentioned above, including the name of the author of each text.
 - We have respected our sources, both textual and visual ones, and we have made sure that our readers can find the same sources with the information that we have provided at the end of each text.

- In our issue...
 - a) each member of our group has written a 1–2-page text analysing his/her own relationship with plastics with the help of the following or other such questions:
 - Do I buy products wrapped in a lot of plastic? Is there a better alternative?
 - Are there microplastics in the hygiene products and cosmetics that I use? Could I stop using them or replace them with products free from microplastics?
 - Do I recycle my plastic bottles and plastic packaging material?
 - Do I buy bad quality products made of plastic? Could I replace them with longer-lasting products?
 - OR b) we have written one text in which each of us answers the abovementioned questions.
