

THE END PRODUCTS TO BE PRESENTED ON FRIDAY

- **1) One issue of a magazine in PDF format** (you can suggest some other format as well).
- Contents
 - a) Presentations of 4-8 cases (1-2 from each country) that have made a positive impact in terms of the plastic challenge
 - at least one case from each partner country + one extra one from any country This last one will be prepared by the Finns of each group!
 - private companies / organizations / public entities focusing on replacing plastics with other materials, recycling plastics or cleaning them from where they don't belong
 - individual people who have made a significant effort to diminish the problem
 - etc.
 - b) Everyone's personal answer to the question: How can I reduce my use of plastics or recycle it better? Is there a personal challenge I should take on?
 - Do I buy products wrapped in a lot of plastic? Is there a better alternative?
 - Are there microplastics in the hygiene products and cosmetics that I use? Could I stop using

them or replace them with products free from microplastics?

- Do I recycle my plastic waste (plastic packaging material)?
- Do I buy bad quality products made of plastic? Could I replace them with more long-lasting products?

- **2) A vlog about what you have learned during the week (one video per group)**
- Format of the presentations:
 - 1-2 pages each
 - with photos
 - respect your sources
 - If you take direct quotes from any of the sources, remember to use quotation marks.
 - Mention the sources used at the end of each presentation (= bibliography).
 - Will each group have their own magazine with a unique name? Or should we have one magazine with a common name and think of each group's contribution as one issue of the same magazine?
 - Is it possible to find at least **seven** different cases from each country? If this is our goal, the national groups must make sure that no two people write about the same case.
